**For reflection this week,  
Questions 10-11 of the Westminster Larger  
Catechism**

**10. Q.** *What are the personal properties of the three persons in the Godhead?*

A. It is proper to the Father to beget the Son, (1) and to the Son to be begotten of the Father, (2) and to the Holy Ghost to proceed from the Father and the Son from all eternity. (3)

1. Heb. 1:5–6, 8.
2. John 1:14, 18.
3. John 15:26; Gal. 4:6.

**11. Q.** *How doth it appear that the Son and the Holy Ghost are God equal with the Father?*

A. The Scriptures manifest that the Son and the Holy Ghost are God equal with the Father, ascribing unto them such names, (1) attributes, (2) works, (3) and worship, (4) as are proper to God only.

1. Isa. 6:3, 5, 8; John 12:41; Acts 28:25; 1 John 5:20; Acts 5:3–4.
2. John 1:1; Isa. 9:6; John 2:24–25; 1 Cor. 2:10–11.
3. Col. 1:16; Gen. 1:2.
