### **For reflection this week, Question 37 of the Westminster Larger Catechism**

**37. Q.** *How did Christ, being the Son of God, become man?*

- A.** Christ the Son of God became man, by taking to himself a true body, and a reasonable soul,<sup>1</sup> being conceived by the power of the Holy Ghost in the womb of the virgin Mary, of her substance, and born of her,<sup>2</sup> yet without sin.<sup>3</sup>
