Redeemer is supporting Al Baker with PCI Ministry. Here is an update from Pastor Jeyaraj Dasan who serves in Hyderabad, Telangana state, India.

Thank you, so much for your regular support. We are blessed by you. Here is a report from your Church planter Ram Babu:

“We serve in the suburb of Hyderabad. Our main ministry is among the migrant laborers. We have been serving in eight locations, of which we conduct worship in two locations. In the rest of the villages, we have evangelism and prayer meetings. Our worship is conducted in the homes as we do not have a place to gather. This has been our major concern.

Prayer requests:

1. Pray for my wife, Shoba's safe delivery and for our daughter's education.
2. Pray for the people who have heard the gospel during Christmas and those who are newly coming to the church.
3. Pray that the Lord would grant us a place to worship.
4. I also serve as the coordinator for a Presbytery. I mentor seven other church planters working with me. Pray for my safe travel.
5. Pray that we will begin all the eight villages we are serving.”
