The Heidelberg Catechism Q. 65: *“It is by faith alone that we share in Christ and all his benefits: Where then does that faith come from?”*

Answer: “The Holy Spirit works it in our hearts by the preaching of the holy gospel, and confirms it by the use of the holy sacraments.”

Q. 66: *“What are sacraments?”*

Answer: “Sacraments are visible, holy signs and seals. They were instituted by God so that by our use of them he might make us understand more clearly the promise of the gospel, and seal that promise. And this is God’s gospel promise: he grants us forgiveness of sins and eternal life because of Christ’s one sacrifice accomplished on the cross.”
