Missions Highlight - Al Baker, PCI Ministry India Mission

We requested prayer for our Discipleship Training from May 1-4, 2023 for our Church planters and disciples/elders of our Churches. God answered your prayers. Thank you, so much. Several of you wrote to assuring your prayers. Grateful to each one of you.

We had 103 participants including the two guest teachers. The participants represented eight different states of India and Nepal. They spoke 12 different languages – however translation was done in two different languages.

We met in two different groups: Telugu and Kannada and offered three different subjects and a total of 48 lectures were given (2400 minutes of teaching). The subjects were: The doctrine of Cross and Resurrection (Al), Hebrews 1-6 (Joe) and Witnessing to the Hindus (Dasan).

- Each day, we began with a time of worship and prayer
- Two days, in the evening, Presbytery meetings were held
- Each day, ended with a time of prayer
- On the fourth day – we had a time of commissioning – Al encouraged the participants to ‘Press on’ and Joe exhorted the participants to ‘Persevere’.
- The Presbytery Coordinators spent time in prayer as the day began
- Al and Joe spent considerable time with the Presbytery Coordinators
