Redeemer is supporting the Parsons family, Christ for the City International, Costa Rica.

This is an update from Michael: We had a Resurrection Party at our house for easter with the kids in La Carpio. It was a wild but beautiful time of having close to 40 kids in our house sharing food together, playing card games, playing games in the yard, and more than anything, just getting the chance to bond with these amazing kids and show them how much we love them.

Recently we've had baptisms at the church we attend, which is connected to the ministry in Reneuvos. My approach to ministry is this, "people typically don't care what you have to say until they know how much you love them."

Through sharing life with these kids and loving them, that has opened their hearts to see Jesus and to follow Him. And it is so beautiful to be a part of the story God is writing with their lives.

Prayer requests:

- Pray for the kids, that their faith would grow daily and that they would feel how much Jesus loves them in the midst of the crazy that sometimes is their lives.
- Pray for our funding. We are doing well at the moment, but we still are not 100% funded. We can only be here and do the work God allows us to do if we are funded on a monthly basis.
- We know that God will continue to work, He always does, but please pray for the hearts of these kids to be continuously open to the message of the gospel.
