Westminster Larger Catechism Q. 171: *How are they that receive the sacrament of the Lord's Supper to prepare themselves before they come unto it?*

A. They that receive the sacrament of the Lord's Supper are, before they come, to prepare themselves thereunto, by examining themselves of their being in Christ, of their sins and wants; of the truth and measure of their knowledge, faith, repentance; love to God and the brethren, charity to all men, forgiving those that have done them wrong; of their desires after Christ, and of their new obedience; and by renewing the exercise of these graces, by serious meditation, and fervent prayer.

Missions Highlight - Al Baker, PCI Ministry India Mission

Redeemer is supporting Al Baker, India Mission. This is an update from pastor Jeyaraj Dasan, Hyderabad, Telangana state, India:

Dear praying saints, we just would like to give a small report of what is happening in our fields/churches. Please continue to uphold us in prayer. The areas we serve are affected by severe heat waves (about 100 – 110F) and it is only God's grace, we are privileged to serve our God.

Vacation Bible School: Children have summer holidays in the month of May and wherever it is possible we organize vacation Bible School. We bring the children together, teach them songs, Bible stories and have some coloring activities. In the end, we give them a small gift and a certificate. About 50-60 percent of the children would come from other religious backgrounds. We have conducted in many locations and 100's children have attended. Story reaches the family and Gospel is shared

In B'pally PCI church, we conducted VBS for children in that area from 8th to 10th May. There were 45 children. One girl from another religious background, went and shared the Bible stories with her mother. As a result, the mother came to the church and we were able to share the gospel. Let us thank God!
