The Corporate Confession of Sin

“O Eternal God and Most Merciful Father, we confess and acknowledge before your divine majesty that we are miserable sinners, conceived and born in sin and iniquity, so that in us there is no goodness. We continually transgress your holy precepts and commandments. We deserve your just judgment, death, and damnation. We are displeased with ourselves for the sins that we have committed against you. We humbly implore you, O heavenly Father, for Jesus Christ’s sake, that you would have mercy upon us and that you would forgive us all our sins. We ask that you would increase the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. We ask that you would enable us henceforth to mortify our sinful lusts and affections. We ask that you would empower us to bring forth fruit in our lives. To you, O Father, with the Son and the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory. The Assurance of Pardon

“I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.” (Ezekiel 36:25-27)

The Corporate Reading of the Law

“Finally, then, brothers, we ask and urge you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God, just as you are doing, that you do so more and more. For you know what instructions we gave you through the Lord Jesus. For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God; that no one transgress and wrong his brother in this matter, because the Lord is an avenger in all

these things, as we told you beforehand and solemnly warned you.
For God has not called us for impurity, but in holiness.”
