**For reflection this week,
Questions 14 and 15 of the Heidelberg Catechism:**

14 Q. Can another creature—any at all—pay this debt for us?

A. No.

To begin with,
God will not punish any other creature
for what a human is guilty of.¹

Furthermore,
no mere creature can bear the weight
of God's eternal wrath against sin
and deliver others from it.²

**15 Q. What kind of mediator and deliverer should we
look for then?**

A. One who is a true³ and righteous⁴ human, yet more
powerful than all creatures, that is, one who
is also true God.⁵
