- Next weekend, September 6-7: The West Texas Conference on Reformed Theology. Our conference theme is Covenant Theology and is entitled "Covenant and Salvation: God's Faithful Promises." Our speaker is Dr. John Fesko (Ph.D., University of Aberdeen, Scotland), the Harriet Barbour Professor of Systematic and Historical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson, MS, and a minister in the Orthodox Presbyterian Church. He previously served as a church planter, pastor, and as academic dean at Westminster Seminary California. He's the author of many books, including *The Need for Creeds Today*, *The Theology of the Westminster Standards*, *Romans*, and *Signed, Sealed, and Delivered: An Introduction to Covenant Theology* with Ligonier Ministries.
