The Corporate Confession of Sin

“Merciful Father, we humble ourselves before your great Majesty against which we have frequently and grievously sinned. We are unclean before you. We continually transgress your commandments, failing to do what you’ve commanded us to do, and doing that which you’ve expressly forbidden. We acknowledge our waywardness, and are heartily sorry for our sins. We confess that our iniquities are innumerable. We know that our debt is so great that we could never repay it. But we know, O Lord, that you do not desire the death of the sinner, but rather that he should turn to you and live. We call upon you in repentance, trusting in our Mediator, Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Have mercy upon us. Forgive us our transgressions. Wash us in the pure fountain of Christ’s blood. Cover us with his righteousness. This we ask through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.” (adapted from the *Dutch Reformed Psalter*, 1566)

The Assurance of Pardon

“What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? Who shall bring any charge against God’s elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.” (Romans 8:31-34)
