The Corporate Confession of Sin

“Almighty and Everlasting Father, we confess that we have sinned against you. We have fallen short of your glory. We have not loved you with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. We have not loved

our neighbor as ourselves. You warn that whoever keeps the whole law and stumbles at one point is guilty of all. We acknowledge our guilt. We rightly fall under your judgment. Have mercy upon us, O Lord, for Christ's sake. Blot out our transgressions. Wash us from our iniquities. Forgive us our sins. Remove our transgressions as far as the east is from the west. Cast all our sins behind your back and remember them no more. This we ask in Christ's name. Amen." The Assurance of Pardon

"God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. . . . They put him to death by hanging him on a tree, but God raised him on the third day. . . . And he commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one appointed by God to be judge of the living and the dead. To him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name." (Acts 10:38-40, 42-43)
