Question 26 of the Heidelberg Catechism:**

26 Q. What do you believe when you say, “I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth”?

- A. That the eternal Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
who out of nothing created heaven and earth
and everything in them,¹
who still upholds and rules them
by his eternal counsel and providence,²
is my God and Father
because of Christ the Son.³

I trust God so much that I do not doubt
he will provide
whatever I need
for body and soul,⁴
and will turn to my good
whatever adversity he sends upon me
in this sad world.⁵

God is able to do this because he is almighty God⁶
and desires to do this because he is a faithful Father.⁷
